

## Newcastle Parks Trust – Public Information Sharing Sessions

### Proposed Governance - July 2018

Over the last few months we have been continuing to set up the Newcastle Parks Trust, to care for and develop our parks and allotments in the future. We are now at a stage where we would like to meet with you again, to share some specific information with you. We have arranged 3 open sessions in July which we hope you will be able to attend. We would like to cover the following:-

1. **Governance:** explain the proposed governance structure for the Trust in more detail and share the constitution with you (Articles of Association).
2. **Community Representation Sub-Group:** the public consultation we undertook back in 2017 made it clear that the community would like to see their interests and views transparently and formally included within the Trust's structure. We have therefore included a "Community Representation Group" within the governance, as a sub-committee of the Board of Trustees. We have also constructed draft Terms of Reference with support from the Parks Forum, Allotment Working Group and community and third sector focus groups facilitated by NCVS. We would now like to share the Draft Terms of Reference more widely with the general public.
