

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE
TRAFFIC REGULATION (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009
(POTTERY LANE VARIATION) ORDER 2019**

The Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of their powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009, as amended, (“the Order”) is hereby further varied by
 - (a) the deletion of the wording specified in the first entry relating to the south side in Item 751 of Schedule 2 thereto and the addition, by way of replacement, of the wording specified in the Schedule to this Order, and
 - (b) the deletion therefrom of Item 61 (b) (ii) from Schedule 16A.
2. In this Order, unless otherwise specified, references to Articles and Schedules shall be construed as references to Articles and Schedules of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009.
3. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
4. This Order shall come into operation on xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx, and may be cited as the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Pottery Lane Variation) Order 2019.
