## CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE (VARIOUS ROADS – OUSIDE OF SCHOOLS) SPEED LIMIT ORDER 2019

The Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne, in exercise of their powers under Section 84 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as "the Act") and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

- 1. No person shall cause or permit any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the roads and lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order.
- The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any other enactment.
- 3. This Order shall come into operation on xxxxxxxxxxxxx 2019, and may be cited as the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Various Roads Outside of Schools) Speed Limit Order 2019.
