

**(CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE)  
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009  
(ELECTRIC VEHICLES VARIATION) ORDER 2018**

The Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of their powers under Sections 32 (1) 35 (1) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”) and of all other powers them enabling in that behalf and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. The City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009, as amended, is hereby further varied by -
  - (a) the addition into Article 3 (1) of the following –

**“Electric Vehicle”** means any vehicle which uses one or more electric motors for propulsion.

**“Electric Vehicle Charging Post”** means apparatus which supplies electricity for the charging of Electric Vehicles.
  - (b) the deletion of the wording in Article 5 (9) (f) and the addition, by way of replacement, of the following wording –

“that certain bays are for the use of Electric Vehicles only then no person shall park in any such bay unless

    - (i) the vehicle is an Electric Vehicle, and
    - (ii) the vehicle is connected to the Electric Vehicle Charging Post relating to that parking bay.”
  - (c) the deletion therefrom of Article 19 (3) (e).
2. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any regulation made or having effect as if made under the Act, or by or under any other enactment.
3. This Order shall come into operation on xxxxxxxxxxxxxxxx, and may be cited as the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (Electric Vehicles Variation) Order 2018.
