- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the 2009 Consolidation Order").
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to
 - (a) amend the length of existing no waiting at any time (double yellow lines) restriction on both sides of **Back George Street** so that it extends over the entire length of the street (except at designated parking places) (the restriction currently extends from George Way southwards for 115 metres);
 - (b) prohibit waiting at any time (double yellow lines) on **Elswick East Terrace** east side, from 10 metres north of Back George Street southwards and westwards for a total of 144 metres.
 - (c) amend the length of existing no waiting between 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday restriction on the east side of **Elswick East Terrace** so that it extends from 15 metres south of George Way southwards for 110 metres (restriction currently extends from 15 metres south of George Way southwards for 133 metres).
- (ii) (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (Back George Street Variation)

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 ("the 2009 On Street Order").
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to designate the following length of road as a Parking Place where waiting is limited to 2 hours, no return for 6 hours, between 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday
 - (i) **Back George Street** south side, from 7 metres east of Elswick East Terrace eastwards for 30 metres.
