

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE
(NEWCASTLE GREAT PARK)
SPEED LIMIT ORDER (No. 3) 2017**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Section 84 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
2. The effect of the proposed Order is -
 - (i) to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit on **Wagonway Drive** – from Roseden Way northwards for 380 metres; and
 - (ii) to extend the length of 20mph speed limit on **Roseden Way** so that it applies to the entire length of the street (currently applies from Esh Plaza to 210 metres west of Swinhoe Road).
3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order (including a draft Order, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order) can be viewed free of charge at -
