

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE  
PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS  
YEWCROFT AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to **construct road humps** complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 in **Yewcroft Avenue**.
2. All of the road humps specified below will extend over the full width of the carriageway, be 85mm in height and have ramp gradients of 1:10. The proposed nature, locations and lengths are as follows:-

Nature

**Raised Tables**

Locations (to the centre of the raised tables) -

1. **Yewcroft Avenue (east-west)** – at its junction with Broadmead Way,
2. **Yewcroft Avenue (east-west)** – 60 metres east of its junction with Broadmead Way,
3. **Yewcroft Avenue (east-west)** – at its junction with Sandmere Place,
4. **Yewcroft Avenue (east-west)** – 35 metres west of its junction with Muswell Hill.

Lengths along the carriageway to be –

1. 4 metres
2. along Yewcroft Avenue (east-west) – 17 metres and along Yewcroft Avenue (north-south) – 8 metres
3. along Yewcroft Avenue – 22.7 metres and along Sandmere Place – 7 metres
4. along Yewcroft Avenue (east-west) – 17.7 metres and along Yewcroft Avenue (north-south) – 7 metres

**Note** – all of the existing buildouts on the section of Yewcroft Avenue between Broadmead Way and Muswell Hill will be removed as part of this scheme.

  - (c) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
