

**City of Newcastle upon Tyne
(On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 [2017]
(Rock Terrace, Shieldfield Variation) Order 2017**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (“the 2009 Order”). Note – the Council are currently in the process of making a new 2017 Order. If the 2017 Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the 2017 Order.
2. The effect of the proposed Order is -
 - (a) to designate the following length of road as a parking place for disabled badge holders. The parking place will operate all hours and all days -

Rock Terrace – north side, from 29 metres west of Shield Street westwards for 4.5 metres.
 - (b) to designate the following lengths of road as parking places for permit holders only which will operate between 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday -
 - (i) **Rock Terrace** – north side, from 14 metres west of Shield Street westwards for 15 metres;
 - (ii) **Rock Terrace** – north side, from 33.5 metres west of Shield Street westwards for 10 metres

Vehicles displaying valid parking permits for Parking Zone OB1 will be able to park at the above parking places during the hours of operation.
 - (c) to amend the parking place on the east side of Rock Terrace in the layby to the north of Pandon Court so that it extends to include the area (unadopted) between Pandon Court and Lort House
3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order (including draft Order, map and a statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order), and a copy of the 2009 Order are available for inspection at -
 - (a) Customer Services, Central Library, Charles Avison Building, 33 New Bridge Street West, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8AX between 10.00 am and 4.30 pm Monday to Friday,
 - (b) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm Monday to Friday.
