

## CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE

### REMOVAL OF PEDESTRIAN CROSSING - GRAINGER STREET

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police gives notice of its intention to remove the existing pedestrian (Puffin) crossing at the following location -

**Grainger Street** - 17 metres west of its junction with Nun Street.

(Note – a no waiting at any time restriction will be applied in place of the crossing once it is removed in line with the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (City Centre Controlled Parking Zone) Restriction of Waiting Order 2009).

2. The removal of the crossing is necessary as its location in proximity to 2 other crossings makes it difficult for motorists to identify the correct signal when approaching the crossing, and to improve public transport reliability around the city centre.
3. A copy of this Notice and a plan showing the location of the crossing to be removed may be viewed free of charge for 21 days after publication of this Notice at –
  - (a) Customer Services, Newcastle Central Library, Charles Avison Building, 33 New Bridge Street West, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8AX between 10.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday, and
  - (b) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
