(i) (Prestwick Road Area, Dinnington) Speed Limit Order 2017

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is -
 - (a) to introduce a 20 miles per hour speed limit on the following lengths of road
 - (i) **Alwin Grove** for its entire length;
 - (ii) **Bowmont Chase** for its entire length;
 - (iii) **Glen Drive** for its entire length;
 - (iv) **Front Street, Dinnington** for its entire length;
 - (v) **Prestwick Road (including March Terrace and South View)** from Front Street, Dinnington to 224 metres south west of Prestwick Carr Road.
 - (vi) **Rede Place** for its entire length;
 - (b) to introduce a 30 miles per hour speed limit on the following length of road -
 - (i) **Prestwick Road** from 224 metres south west of Prestwick Carr Road westwards for 175 metres.
 - (c) to revoke the existing 20 miles per hour speed restriction on the entire length of **Prestwick Road**.

(ii) **Proposed Construction of Road Humps – Prestwick Road, Dinnington**

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to construct road humps complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 in Prestwick Road, Dinnington.
- 2. The proposed nature, dimensions and location of the road humps are as follows:-

Nature

Speed Cushions

Locations

(i) **Prestwick Road** – from a point 155 metres west of its junction with Farndale Close;

(ii) **Prestwick Road** – from a point 257 metres west of its junction with Farndale Close

Dimensions

Length along the carriageway to be 3.6 metres. Width across the carriageway to be 1.7 metres. Height to be 85 mm Ramp gradients to be 1 in 10 Side tapers to be 1 in 6.
