## CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE TRAFFIC REGULATION (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 (PRINCES MEADOW VARIATION) ORDER 2018

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the 2009 Order"). Note the Council is in the process of making a new Consolidation Order ("the new Order"). If the new Order is made before the proposed Variation Order, then the proposed Variation Order will become an amendment to the new Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a prohibition of waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of **Princes Meadow** -
  - (a) south side, from 10 metres west of northern junction with Princes Meadow (north-south leg) eastwards for 20 metres;
  - (b) both sides
    - (i) from Princes Meadow (east-west leg adjacent to No. 36) southwards for 8 metres;
    - (ii) (east-west leg adjacent to No. 25) from Princes Meadow (north-south leg) eastwards for 8 metres;
    - (iii) (east-west leg adjacent to Nos. 14 and 22) from Princes Meadow (north-south leg) westwards for 11 metres;
    - (iv) from 118 metres north of Emblehope Drive northwards for 54 metres;
  - (c) west side, from 185 metres north of Emblehope Drive northwards for 22 metres:
  - (d) east side -
    - (i) from 190 metres north of Emblehope Drive northwards for 18 metres:
    - (ii) from 51 metres north of Emblehope Drive northwards for 28 metres.
