ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

PROPOSED CHANGE TO PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – NEWTON ROAD

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police gives notice of its intention to change the existing Zebra crossing on Newton Road located 50 metres east of Boundary Gardens into a Puffin crossing.

As the new Puffin Crossing will be slightly wider than the existing zebra crossing, its location will be -

Newton Road – 51 metres east of its junction with Boundary Gardens (measured to the centre of the crossing) (length of Restricted Area along the carriageway to be 25 metres).

2. The pedestrian crossing is necessary to facilitate pedestrians crossing Newton Road.

 - (a) Customer Services, Newcastle Central Library, Charles Avison Building, 33 New Bridge Street West, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8AX between 10.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday, and
 - (b) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
