MINISTRY CLOSE AREA

(i) (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (Ministry Close Variation) Order 2018

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 ("the On Street Order"). (Note – the Council are in the process of making a new On Street Parking Places Order ("the new On Street Order"). If the new On Street Order is made before the proposed Variation Order, then the proposed Variation Order will become an amendment to the new On Street Order).
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to extend the hours of operation of the permit holders only parking restriction at Ministry Close so that only permit holders will be allowed to park between the hours of 8am and 5pm Monday to Friday (currently the restricted hours are permit holders only between 10am and 11am and 2pm and 3pm Monday to Friday.)

(i) Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Ministry Close Area Variation) Order 2018

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the Consolidation Order"). Note – the Council are in the process of making a new Consolidation Order ("the new Consolidation Order"). If the new Consolidation Order is made before the proposed Variation Order, then the proposed Variation Order will become an amendment to the new Consolidation Order.
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a no waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road -

(a) Ministry Close –

- (i) east/west section – both sides, for the full length of between the Link Road leading to the Ministry and Ministry Close north/south section;
- (ii) north/south section – west side, from 8 metres north of Ministry Close east/west section southwards for 17 metres; and
- (iii) north/south section – east side, from 10 metres north of Ministry Close east/west section southwards for 21 metres.

(b) Link Road leading to the Ministry –

- (i) both sides (of each carriageway) for the full length between Benton Park Road and the Ministry. (Note – this will have the effect of

formalising the double yellow lines which are currently in place on the ground).

Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders (including draft Orders, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders), and the Consolidation Order and On Street Order may be inspected free of charge at -
