Hexham Road Area

(i) Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Hexham Road Variation) Order 2017

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (“the 2009 Consolidation Order”).

2. The effect of the proposed Order is to:-

- (1) alter an existing length of **no waiting at any time restriction** (double yellow lines) so that it extends as follows –

Hexham Road – south side, from Hill House Road eastwards for 121 metres (currently extends from Hill House Road eastwards for 100 metres);

(ii) (Hexham Road) Speed Limit Order 2017

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

2. The effect of the proposed Order is introduce a **20mph speed limit** on the following length of road -

Hexham Road – from Ponteland Road to 54 metres west of Hill House Road.

(iii) Proposed Construction of Road Humps – Hexham Road

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to **construct road humps** complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 in **Hexham Road**.

2. The proposed nature, dimensions and locations of the road humps are as follows:-

Nature

- (1) **Speed Cushion**

Locations

- (a) Hexham Road – 48 metres east of its junction with Ollerton Drive;
- (b) Hexham Road – 130 metres east of its junction with Ollerton Drive;
- (c) Hexham Road – 72 metres west of its junction with Coach Road;
- (d) Hexham Road – 13.7 metres west of its junction with North Farm Court;
- (e) Hexham Road – 82.4 metres west of its junction with North Farm Court;
- (f) Hexham Road – 142 metres west of its junction with North Farm Court;

Dimensions

All of the speed cushions specified above will have the following dimensions -

Length along the carriageway to be 3.6 metres

Width across the carriageway to be 1.7 metres

Height to be 85 mm

Ramp gradients to be 1 in 10

Side ramp to be 1 in 6

(2) Raised Table

Location

- (a) Hexham Road – 23 metres east of its junction with Coach Road

Dimensions

Length along the carriageway to be 8.3 metres

Width across the carriageway to be full width

Height to be 85 mm

Ramp gradients to be 1 in 20.

(iv) Proposed Pedestrian Crossings – Hexham Road Area

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne, in exercise of its powers under Section 23(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to establish pedestrian crossings at the following locations –

A. Puffin Crossings

- (a) **Hexham Road** – 23 metres east of its junction with Coach Road (measured to the centre of the crossing) (length of Restricted Area along the carriageway to be 30.5 metres);

- (b) **Ponteland Road** - 13.5 metres north of its junction with Alston Gardens (measured to the centre of the crossing) (length of Restricted Area along the carriageway to be 43.3 metres)

B. **Zebra Crossing**

Hexham Road – 160 metres west of its junction with Ponteland Road (measured to the centre of the crossing) (length of Restricted Area along the carriageway to be 40 metres)

Note - the existing zebra crossing located 188 metres west of Ponteland Road will be removed.

The above crossings are necessary to facilitate pedestrians crossing Hexham Road and Ponteland Road.

Documents giving more detailed particulars of all of the proposals specified in this Notice (including draft Orders, Notice, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for making the proposals), and the 2009 Consolidation Order may be inspected free of charge at –
