FORTH STREET

(i) Proposed Pedestrian Crossing – Forth Street

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne, in exercise of its powers under Section 23(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to establish a pedestrian crossing at the following location -

Zebra Crossing –

Forth Street - 31 metres west of its junction with Sussex Street (controlled area from a point 19.5 metres west of its junction with Sussex Street in a westerly direction for a distance of 27 metres)

The crossing is necessary to facilitate pedestrians crossing Forth Street.

(ii) Proposed Construction of Road Hump – Forth Street

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to construct a road hump complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 in Forth Street.
2. The proposed nature, dimensions and location of the road hump are as follows:-

Nature - Raised Table

Location – Forth Street - from a point 17.5 metres west of Sussex Street westwards for 45.5 metres

Dimensions

The raised table will extend over the full width of the carriageway and be 85mm in height with ramp gradients of 1:10. The length of the raised table will be from a point 17.5 metres west of its junction with Sussex Street to a point 45.5 metres west of its junction with Sussex Street.

Details of the pedestrian crossing and road hump, together with a plan, may be inspected free of charge at –
