CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE (ON STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009 (ESKDALE TERRACE VARIATION) ORDER 2018

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 ("the 2009 On Street Order"). Note the Council is currently considering making a new On Street Order ("the new Order"). If the new Order is made before the proposed Variation Order, then the proposed Variation Order will become an amendment to the new Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to revoke the provision that all properties in **Eskdale Terrace** are eligible to apply for parking permits for the J1 parking zone. It is proposed that properties eligible for Parking Permits will be limited to Nos. 2-20 (even), 1-5 (odd), 27-37 (odd), 41, 41A, all of Eskdale Mansions and Royal Grammar School. Full details of permit issue/renewal, conditions of use, discounts and types of permit are contained in the 2009 On Street Order which may be viewed at the location specified in paragraph 3 below.
- 3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order (including draft Order, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order), and the 2009 On Street Order may be inspected free of charge at -
