ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – SALTERS ROAD

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police gives notice of its intention to
 - (a) **remove** the existing Zebra crossing on **Salters Road** located 25.4 metres east of Edward Street, and
 - (b) **install** a Puffin crossing in a new location on **Salters Road**. The new crossing will be located 14.4 metres west of its junction with Ivy Road (length of Restricted Area along the carriageway to be 39 metres).
2. The Puffin crossing is necessary to provide a facility on Salters Road which is sufficient for the number of pedestrians crossing on this road.
3. A copy of this Notice and a plan showing the location of the crossing may be viewed free of charge at -
 - (a) Customer Services, Newcastle Central Library, Charles Avison Building, 33 New Bridge Street West, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8AX between 10.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday, and
 - (b) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.Details can also be viewed at www.letstalknewcastle.co.uk under “Traffic related consultations”.
