ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 – SECTION 23

PROPOSED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING – FRONT STREET, DINNINGTON

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police gives notice of its intention to establish (install) a **zebra crossing** at the following location:-

Front Street, Dinnington – 25.5 metres west of its junction with Glen Drive for the full width of the carriageway.

2. The proposed zebra crossing is necessary to facilitate pedestrians crossing the above road.
3. A copy of this Notice and a plan showing the location of the proposed crossing may be viewed free of charge for 21 days after publication of this Notice at –
 - (a) Customer Services, Central Library, Charles Avison Building, 33 New Bridge Street West, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8AX between 10.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday,
 - (b) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00 am to 4.30 pm Monday to Friday.
