- (i) Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Helmsley Road Variation)
 Order 2019
- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the Consolidation Order"). Note the Council are considering making a new Consolidation Order. If the new Consolidation Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the new Consolidation Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a no waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of **Helmsley Road**
 - (a) north west side, from 25 metres north east of Goldspink Lane north eastwards for 9 metres;
 - (b) north west side, from 51 metres north east of Goldspink Lane north eastwards for 7 metres;

Note – sections of the existing limited stay parking place will be removed to accommodate the double yellow lines.

- (ii) (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (Helmsley Road Variation) Order 2019
- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 ("the On Street Order"). Note the Council are considering making a new On Street Order. If the new On Street Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the new On Street Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to revoke 2 sections of the existing limited waiting/permit parking place on the north west side of **Helmsley Road** to accommodate the above double yellow lines. The remaining limited waiting parking place will then apply to the following lengths of road -
 - (a) from 6 metres north east of Goldspink Lane north eastwards for 19 metres;
 - (b) from 34 metres north east of Goldspink Lane north eastwards for 17 metres; and
 - (c) from 58 metres north east of Goldspink Lane north eastwards for 13 metres.
