

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE
PROPOSED CONSTRUCTION OF ROAD HUMPS
EDGEFIELD AVENUE**

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to **construct road humps** complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 in **Edgefield Avenue**.
2. The proposed nature, dimensions and locations of the road humps are as follows:-

Nature

Speed Cushions (x3)

Dimensions

Length along the carriageway to be 3.6 metres.

Width across the carriageway to be 1.7 metres (per cushion).

Height to be 85 mm

Ramp gradients to be 1 in 10

Locations (to the centre of the road humps) -

Edgefield Avenue –

- (a) 40.5 metres north of its junction with **Willowfield Avenue**,
- (b) 54.6 metres south of its junction with **Willowfield Avenue**,
- (c) 40.9 metres north of its junction with **Cloverfield Avenue**.
