

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE
(ON STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009
(BRENTWOOD AVENUE, JESMOND VARIATION) ORDER 2018**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (“the 2009 On Street Order”). (Note – the Council are considering making a new On Street Parking Places Order (“the new Order”). If the new Order is made before the proposed Variation Order, then the proposed Variation Order will become an amendment to the new Order).

2. **The effect of the proposed Order is to convert one of the existing Electric Vehicle parking spaces on the north east side of Brentwood Avenue, Jesmond into a parking space for Newcastle Car Club vehicles.**

The proposed Car Club parking space will operate all days and all times and extend on that length of the north east side of Brentwood Avenue from 78.9 metres south east of Mayfair Road south eastwards for 5 metres.

The remaining Electric Vehicle parking space will extend on that length of the north east side of Brentwood Avenue from 73.9 metres south east of Mayfair Road south eastwards for 5 metres.

3. **Documents** giving more detailed particulars of the Order (including draft Order, map and a statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order), and the 2009 On Street Order **may be inspected** free of charge at -

(a) Customer Services, Central Library, Charles Avison Building, 33 New Bridge Street West, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8AX between 10.00 am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday, and

(b) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00 am and 4.30 pm Monday to Friday.
