WEST ROAD

(i) **Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (West Road Variation) Order 2018**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the Consolidation Order"). Note – the Council are considering making a new Consolidation Order ("the new Order"). If the new Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the new Order.
2. The effect of the proposed Order is -
 - (a) to increase in length an existing no waiting at any time restriction on the **south side of West Road** so that it extends from Fox and Hounds Lane to 72.1 metres west of Denhill Park (currently extends from Fox and Hounds Lane to 88.1 metres west of Denhill Park);
 - (b) to increase in length an existing no loading and unloading between 8am-9.15am and 4pm-6pm Monday to Friday restriction on the **south side of West Road** so that it extends from Fox and Hounds Lane to 72.1 metres west of Denhill Park (currently extends from Fox and Hounds Lane to 88.1 metres west of Denhill Park);

(ii) **(On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (West Road Variation) Order 2018**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 ("the On Street Order"). (Note – the Council are considering making a new On Street Parking Places Order ("the new Order"). If the new Order is made before the proposed variation Order, then the proposed variation Order will become an amendment to the new Order).
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to reduce in length an existing 2 hour limited waiting parking place operative between 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday on the **south side of West Road** so that it extends from 48.1 metres west of Denhill Park westwards for 24 metres (currently extends from 48.1 metres west of Denhill Park westwards for 40 metres).

Documents giving more detailed particulars of the proposals specified in this Notice (including draft Orders, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposals), and the Consolidation Order and On Street Order may be inspected free of charge at -

- (c) Newcastle Civic Centre, Barras Bridge, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.
