

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE  
(ON STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009  
(BURDON TERRACE VARIATION) ORDER 2018**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (“the On Street Order”). (Note – the Council are considering making a new On Street Parking Places Order (“the new Order”). If the new Order is made before the proposed Variation Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the new Order).
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to -
  - (a) designate the following length of **Burdon Terrace** as a parking place for Buses. The parking place will operate between 8.00am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday for Buses only -
    - (i) north side, from 38 metres west of Tankerville Terrace westwards for 22 metres;
  - (b) designate the following lengths of **Burdon Terrace** as parking places with parking meters for use by motor cars, invalid carriages and motor cycles. The parking charge, payable between 8am and 6.30pm Monday to Saturday, will be 60p per hour and the maximum period of stay will be 4 hours. Payment of the parking charge can be made at the ticket machine or by mobile telephone. Where the telephone payment service is used to pay a parking charge a transaction fee of 14p is also payable –
    - (i) north side, from 27 metres west of Tankerville Terrace westwards for 11 metres; and
    - (ii) north side, from 60 metres west of Tankerville Terrace westwards for 116 metres;
  - (c) revoke the existing parking places with parking meters on the following lengths of the north side of **Burdon Terrace** –
    - (i) from 14 metres east of Abbotsford Terrace eastwards for 62 metres;
    - (ii) from 27 metres west of Tankerville Terrace westwards for 48 metres.

**Note** – the above proposals replace the parking places proposals for Burdon Terrace advertised in the Journal on 16 August 2017 which are not being proceeded with.
