- (i) (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (Rye Hill Variation) Order 2019
- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 ("the On Street Order"). Note the Council are considering making a new On Street Order. If the new On Street Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the new On Street Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to -
 - (a) designate the following length of road as a parking place for Disabled Person's Badge holders only. The parking place will be in operation all days and all times
 - **Rye Hill** west side, from 40 metres south of Westmorland Road southwards for 3 metres;
 - (b) designate the following length of road as a parking place with parking meters for use by motor cars, invalid carriages and motor cycles. The parking charge, which is payable between 8am and 6.30pm all days, will be 50p per hour and the maximum period of stay is 24 hours. Payment of the parking charge can be made at the ticket machine or by mobile telephone. Where the telephone payment service is used to pay a parking charge a transaction fee of 14p is also payable -

Rye Hill - west side, from 10 metres south of Westmorland Road southwards for 30 metres.

(ii) Proposed Construction of Road Humps – Rye Hill

- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN in accordance with Section 90C of the Highways Act 1980 that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne in exercise of its powers under Section 90A of the Highways Act 1980 proposes to construct road humps complying with the Highways (Road Humps) Regulations 1999 in Rye Hill.
- 2. Both of the road humps specified below will extend over the full width of the carriageway, be 75mm in height and the gradient of the ramps will be 1:20. The proposed nature, locations and lengths are as follows:-

Nature – Road Humps

Locations -

- (i) Rye Hill 14 metres north of its junction with Westmorland Road,
- (ii) Rye Hill 34 metres north of its junction with Houston Street

Lengths along the carriageway to be -

- (i) 6 metres
- (ii) 6 metres.
