TANKERVILLE TERRACE

(i) **Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 [2017] (Tankerville Terrace Variation) Order 2017**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (“the Consolidation Order”). Note – the Council are currently in the process of making a new 2017 Consolidation Order (“the 2017 Order”). If the 2017 Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the 2017 Order.
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a no waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of **the west side of Tankerville Terrace** -
 - (a) from 44 metres north of Burdon Terrace northwards for 6 metres; and
 - (b) from 62 metres north of Back Haldane Terrace (North) northwards for 16 metres.

(Note – across the two entrances to Newcastle High School for Girls)

(ii) **(On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 [2017] (Tankerville Terrace Variation) Order 2017**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35, 45, 46, 49, 53, 63 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (On Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (“the On Street Order”). (Note – the Council are currently in the process of making a new 2017 On Street Parking Places Order (“the 2017 Order”). If the 2017 Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the 2017 Order).
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to –
 - (1) remove from the On Street Order the length of charged parking place on **the west side of Tankerville Terrace** from 62 metres north of Back Haldane Terrace (North) northwards for 16 metres as it no longer exists on the ground;
 - (2) re-describe in the On Street Order the 3 lengths of charged parking place on the west side of Tankerville Terrace which are located north of Back Haldane Terrace (North) and south of Tankerville Place. This is an administrative change only and there will be no change on the ground.
