CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE TRAFFIC REGULATION (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009 [2017] (SOUTH VIEW AREA VARIATION) ORDER 2017

- 1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the 2009 Order"). Note the Council are currently in the process of making a new 2017 Consolidation Order ("the 2017 Order"). If the 2017 Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the 2017 Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to introduce a prohibition of waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) on the following lengths of road
 - (a) **Mill Hill Road** both sides, from Thornley Road eastwards for 8 metres;
 - (b) **South View –** north side, from 13 metres east of Thornley Road westwards for 42.4 metres;
 - (c) Thornley Road -
 - (i) east side, from 17 metres north of Mill Hill Road southwards for 39.4 metres:
 - (ii) east side, from South View to 35 metres south of Mill Hill Road;
 - (iii) west side, from South View to 19 metres south of Mill Hill Road.
- 3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order (including draft Order, map and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order), and the 2009 Order, may be inspected free of charge at
