

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE
TRAFFIC REGULATION (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2009
(LANCEFIELD AVENUE AREA VARIATION) ORDER 2020**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (“the 2009 Order”).
2. **The effect** of the proposed Order **is to** -
 - (a) **introduce a prohibition of waiting at any time restriction (double yellow lines) on** the following lengths of road –
 - (1) **Chalfont Road** – both sides, from Lancefield Avenue northwards for 10.7 metres
 - (2) **Lancefield Avenue** –
 - (i) south side, from 3.2 metres south west of Chalfont Road eastwards for 14.6 metres,
 - (ii) north side, from 8.4 metres south west of Chalfont Road eastwards for 19.8 metres,
 - (b) **introduce a prohibition of loading/unloading at any time restriction on** the following lengths of road –
 - (1) **Chalfont Road** – both sides, from Lancefield Avenue northwards for 10.7 metres.
 - (2) **Lancefield Avenue** –
 - (i) south east side, from 11.4 metres north east of Chalfont Road southwards for 55.4 metres,
 - (ii) north side, from 8.4 metres south west of Chalfont Road eastwards for 19.8 metres,
 - (iii) east side, from 23.1 metres north of Readhead Drive southwards direction for 44.9 metres,
 - (3) **Readhead Drive** – both sides, from Lancefield Avenue eastwards for 11.9 metres.
