- (i) Proposed Pedestrian Crossing Bedeburn Road
- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne, in exercise of its powers under Section 23(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police proposes to establish a pedestrian crossing at the following location –

## **Puffin Crossing**

**Bedeburn Road** – 17.2 metres south of its junction with Bedeburn Foot.

(Length of Restricted Area along the carriageway to be 28.8 metres and width to be full width of the carriageway).

The crossing is necessary to facilitate pedestrians crossing Bedeburn Road.

- (ii) Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Bedeburn Road Variation)
  Order 2021
- NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne propose to make an Order under Sections 1, 2, 4, 29 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 ("the Consolidation Order"). Note the Council are considering making a new Consolidation Order. If the new Consolidation Order is made before the proposed Order, then the proposed Order will become an amendment to the new Consolidation Order.
- 2. The effect of the proposed Order is to revoke (remove) the existing no stopping on school entrance markings restriction on the following length of road –

**Bedeburn Road -** west side, from the point directly opposite the southern kerbline of the access road leading to Bedeburn Road southwards for 43.56 metres.
