STATEMENT OF REASONS

City of Newcastle upon Tyne Traffic Regulation (Consolidation) Order 2009 (Baxter Avenue and Hoyle Avenue Area Variation) Order 2019

The Council's reasons for proposing to make the above Order are as follows:-

Concerns have been raised regarding obstructive parking in the area which is causing access issues, particularly for pedestrians.

Vehicles frequently park in a manner as to block the footway and as a result, pedestrians are forced to walk into the carriageway.

In addition, vehicles are parking on the bend between Baxter Avenue and Hoyle Avenue, restricting visibility and reducing road safety.

To address this inconsiderate parking it is proposed to introduce no waiting at any time restrictions at various locations in the area. These restrictions should discourage this dangerous parking and improve road safety.
