

**CITY OF NEWCASTLE UPON TYNE
(OFF STREET PARKING PLACES) ORDER 2009
(WEST DENTON COMMUNITY CENTRE CAR PARK VARIATION) ORDER
2017**

1. **NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that the Council of the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (“the Council”) propose to make an Order under Sections 32, 35 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which amends the City of Newcastle upon Tyne (Off Street Parking Places) Order 2009 (“the 2009 Order”).
2. The effect of the proposed Order is to **introduce parking regulations and conditions at West Denton Community Centre car park** (the car park is located adjacent to West Denton Community Centre, Hillhead Road). Parking will be free of charge and it will be available all days/all hours for passenger vehicles, motor cycles, invalid carriages and goods vehicles not in excess of 1117 kg (30 cwt) unladen weight or 6.1m (20 ft) in length. The maximum length of stay will be 24 hours. The parking place will be added into the 2009 Order and therefore the provisions and conditions of that Order will apply to it.
3. Documents giving more detailed particulars of the Order (including draft Order, map and a statement of the Council’s reasons for proposing to make the Order), and the 2009 Order, may be inspected free of charge at
 - (a) the Customer Service Centre, Civic Centre, (Ground Floor), Sandyford Road, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE1 8QH between 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday; and
 - (b) the Outer West Customer Service Centre, Denton Park Shopping Centre, West Denton Way, Newcastle upon Tyne, NE5 2QZ between 10am and 2pm on Tuesday, 10am and 6pm on Thursday and 10am and 5pm on Friday (closed on Monday and Wednesday).
